Bible Text: Psalm 145:10-16

Reflection:

King David's psalm is a song of praise to the eternal King whose kingdom will never end. Unlike earthly rulers, God's reign is marked by perfect goodness, justice, compassion, faithfulness, and steadfast love. He upholds those who are weak, lifts up those who have fallen, and faithfully cares for all who belong to Him. Throughout every generation, God's people can confidently praise Him because His character never changes.

As we reflect on God's faithfulness in our own lives and throughout the history of CBCM, we are reminded that our hope in uncertain times is not found in anyone or anything because they all will change and none of them of absolute sovereign power and authority, but in our unchanging King alone who does. He has faithfully ruled over His church in the past, and He will continue to lead us as we move forward in His mission.
