

Day 3: July 7th Tuesday

Bible Text: Deut 7:6-9

Reflection:

Our God is a covenant keeping faithful loving God. He was faithful to the Israelites in the Old Testament, and through the new covenant of Jesus Christ, He is faithful to us as His people. Moses reminds Israel that God chose them not because of their greatness or merit, but because of His sovereign love and faithfulness to His promises. God's covenant love is rooted in His character, not our performance. Likewise, God has graciously called us to belong to Him through Christ and has faithfully sustained our church not because of our strength or merit, but because of His steadfast love. Our response is to trust Him, obey Him, and remain faithful to His mission. We should often remind ourselves and cherish the covenantal relationship we now have with God in Christ (1 Pet 2:9-10).

1. How has God shown His covenantal faithfulness to the Israelites? How has God shown His covenantal faithfulness to you and to our church? Give thanks for His covenantal faithfulness.

2. How does remembering that God chose and loves you by grace affect the way you relate to Him today?

3. In what ways can CBCM continue to live as a people set apart for God's purposes in this generation?

Closing Prayer:

Faithful God, thank You that You are a covenant-keeping God whose love never fails. I am humbled that You have called me to belong to You, not because of my worthiness, but because of Your grace and love. Help me to walk faithfully with You, trusting in Your promises and obeying Your Word. We pray also for CBCM, that we would remember our identity as Your chosen people, set apart for Your purposes. Keep us faithful from generation to generation, and use us to display Your steadfast love and truth to the world. In Jesus' name, Amen.
