

Day 6: July 10th Friday

Bible Text: Psalm 23

Reflection:

Psalm 23 paints a beautiful picture of God's faithful care as our Good Shepherd. He provides, guides, protects, comforts, and remains present with us even in our darkest valleys. Even in the presences of our enemies, He leads us to victory and peace. God's faithfulness is not merely seen in extraordinary moments but in His daily presence and care. As individuals and as a church family, we can rest securely knowing that our Good Shepherd will continue to lead us. He is the One who has already gave up His life for us so we may have abundant life in Him (John 10:10-11).

1. In what area of your life do you most need to trust God's shepherding care today? Seek Him now in prayers and cling to Him as your faithful good Shepherd.
2. How has God shepherded and sustained CBCM through difficult seasons, transitions, or uncertainties? Let us give thanks to Him for His faithful shepherding.

Closing Prayer:

Our Heavenly Good Shepherd, thank You for leading, protecting, and providing for me each day. When I am anxious, remind me that I lack nothing because You are with me. When I walk through dark valleys, help me to trust Your presence, follow Your voice, lean on Your comfort. We pray also for CBCM, that we would be a church that rests in Your care, follows Your leading, and joyfully reflects Your goodness and mercy to others. Thank you for shepherding us faithfully until we dwell forever in Your presence. In Jesus' name, Amen.
