

Day 7: July 11th Saturday

Bible Text: Isaiah 46:3–7

Reflection:

While false idols must be carried by people, God is the God who carries His people. From birth to old age, from beginning to end, God faithfully bears, sustains, and saves His children. This truth gives us profound confidence: our future rests not on our strength, but on God's faithfulness. The same God who has carried us individually and carried CBCM through the years will continue to do so.

1. Where are you tempted to rely on your own strength or seeking false "idols" rather than trusting God's sustaining care? Repent and confess your sins, and reaffirm your trust in Him alone.
2. As CBCM looks toward the future, what would it mean for us to depend more fully on God's power and faithfulness rather than our own resources and abilities? Ask God to show us His dream and vision for CBCM and lead us to its fulfillment.

Closing Prayer:

Everlasting God, thank You that You carry me from beginning to end, from my mother's womb into eternity with You. Forgive me for the times I place my trust in things that cannot save or sustain me. Help me to rest in the truth that You alone are my Creator, Savior, and Keeper. Thank You that You have carried me thus far and that You will continue to carry me all the days of my life. We also pray for CBCM, that we would never trust in our own strength, traditions, or resources, but depend wholly on You. Carry our church into the future for Your glory and make us faithful to Your calling until the very end. In Jesus' name, Amen.
